C&L: The children have been learning new topical vocabulary. They have been dressing up as real life superheroes and asking related questions.

Maths: We have been learning about numbers 4 and 5 and thinking about 1 more and 1 less. Please practise writing these numbers at home.

EAD: The children have made their capes which they designed their own logo for. They have also collaged emergency vehicles.

UW: The children have learnt about The Christmas Story and how Christmas is celebrated.
