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C&L: We have been talking about the children's wishes for Christmas

PD: Gross motor—we have been practising our sounds, number formation and the harder to read words 'the', 'to', 'I', 'no', 'go' on large paper and chalk boards using chalk and crayons.

Fine motor: The children have been using tweezers and practising cutting skills.

PSED: We talked about all of the people who help us and what they would like to be when they grow up.

Literacy: In literacy, we have read the story, 'A superhero like you' to finish off the topic of superheroes. The children chose a hero to write about.

Phonics: We have been revising the phase 3 sounds- We have also continued to segment and blend 3 letter CVC words.

Maths: We have been learning about shapes- squares and rectangles.

EAD: We have been making decorations for the hall ready for the school fair and our own Christmas trees.

UW: We have linked winter and Christmas time to changing seasons. We have looked at snow, ice and water and compared the difference.
