Prime Areas

C&L: We have focused on the story of The 3 Little Pigs and the children have retold the story in the role play area.

PD: Gross motor—we have been dancing in our PE sessions and learning about the beat and different ways to move.

Fine motor: The children have been using tweezers to move objects onto pictures to develop the muscles in their fingers..

PSED: We talked about friendships and our special people.

Specific Areas

Literacy: The children have retold the story by making a story map independently. They have written speech bubbles for the pigs and the wolf from the story.

Phonics: We also continue to revise phase 2 & 3. All children should now be quite confident with phase 2 and able to say and write the sounds. They should be able to write several digraphs without prompting.

Maths: We have been focusing on number bonds to 5 and looking at different aspects of time- seconds, minutes, days of the week.

EAD: We have printed our own three little pigs using potatoes and a little pig mask out of a paper plate.

UW: We have looked at the different materials that the 3 little pigs made their houses out of and the properties of those materials.
